CDI-Y, CDI U25, CDI-P horses/ponies may get an FEI Passport but it is not compulsory. CDI-Y, CDI U25, CDI-P horses/ponies that were registered with the FEI prior to 1 Jan 2017 must have their EA horse registration papers with them at the arrival inspection.

- A: An FEI Passport + FEI registration *OR*
 - An EA National Passport & FEI recognition card + FEI registration
- Q: If your horse or pony is competing for the first time in a CDI-Y, U-25 or CDI-P and has not been registered before with the FEI, what does it need to compete?
- A: An EA National Passport + FEI registration OR an FEI Passport + FEI registration
