
## Educational Workshop

Mr Christof Umbach (FEI 5\* Judge from Luxembourg) Christof was born in Germany and moved to Luxembourg in 2000 where he manages the Grand Ducal Dressage Centre along with his partner Grand Prix rider, Sascha Schultz and sponsor Patrice Mourruau. He is responsible for the training of their own horses from young horse up to Grand Prix. Christof is also a "Pferdewirtschaftsmeister", the highest qualification for professional trainers in Germany. The Grand Ducal Team organises the CDI 4\* Dressage Event in Leudelange.

Susan Hoevenaars (FEI 5\*), needs no introduction and is one of Australia's most experienced and respected Judges. having judged at prestigous events round the world including two WEGs and Suzy is on the Judges Panel at the upcoming Tokyo Olympic Games.
